COURSES AVAILABLE:

Academic Subjects with Activities (12-17yrs)

Where better to study the works of Shakespeare than at a British boarding school. Lessons in English literature and Science will be age appropriate and use the excellent facilities on offer. Teachers are all subject specialists and have designed bespoke courses to appeal to international students. They will be academically stretched and challenged and given a taste of what it is to be at a top independent boarding school in the UK.

English Language with Activities (12-17yrs)

This intensive programme of English Language ensures students not only improve their English speaking, writing and listening but also to get a better understanding of British culture and history. Each class will consist of about 10 students in order that they are able to receive the individual attention they deserve.

Junior English Language with Activities (8-1 lyrs)

This Junior programme allows students to feel comfortable and safe and builds on their limited use of English Language. Small classes of about 10 students with highly qualified teachers allows them to improve their reading, writing and speaking in a fun and relaxed environment.

STUDY DAYS:

Study days to Oxford, Bath and London provide students with the opportunity to bring to life what they have learnt in the classroom. Those that study on the Academic subjects with Activities course will also have the opportunity of visiting Stratford Upon Avon, the birthplace of Shakespeare, and home of the Royal Shakespeare company. Before each study day students will receive lessons that prepare them for the visit. Study days provide an interesting and enjoyable way of extending knowledge of English history and culture by allowing students to experience it for themselves.

Students are also given an opportunity to meet and talk with current students at some of the world's top universities and ask them about their own experiences of applying and the interview process.

Students also have the chance of visiting Windsor Castle or Hampton Court Palace and a stadium and museum tour of Chelsea FC.



ACCOMODATION



Students are housed in one of Wellington College's Boarding houses. In previous years students stayed in the Talbot boarding house which has been designed as a spacious, well-appointed and prestigious building in character with others on the Wellington College estate. It occupies a site nestling among mature woodland and landscaped water features. It has an environment, which is homely, secure, comfortable, and conducive to study and in which social contact is natural and easy.

As well as the elegant oak-paneled Dining Room, in which students can take breakfast and supper, the facilities, which are second to none, include a large Common Room with TV, table tennis tables, two rooms for making "Brews" and a separate library room for more quiet study. There are computing and printing facilities in an alcove off the TV room, whilst the well- appointed rooms on the first floor have washing and drying machines which ensure a speedy turn round of students' laundry. Each room has a bed, wardrobe for hanging and storing clothes and a desk. Some rooms have en-suite showers and washing facilities. Outside the building, aside from the lakes and grassy areas, there is a floodlit play area.


The Summer School is set in the beautiful 400 acre estate of Wellington College in Berkshire. Situated to the west of London it is just 30 minutes from Heathrow airport. The grounds of the college include a golf course, large woodland areas and superb facilities for many of the activities.

THE VENUE:

The College was established by Queen Victoria in 1859 as a memorial to the Duke of Wellington who as well as defeating Napoleon at the battle of Waterloo was twice British Prime Minister.
